For more than three decades, Dr. Bea has transformed homes and commercial spaces throughout Ohio and beyond. She launched Bea's Design Center in Columbus, Ohio, a distinctive showroom filled with imported fabrics, furniture, and accessories from Italy to Africa. Lovingly known as "The Queen of Swags," she is celebrated for her signature use of luxurious textiles, timeless drapery, and curated details that make every space feel both beautiful and deeply personal.

Her design eye was sharpened during years spent in Athens, Greece, where she studied architecture, tailoring, and craftsmanship alongside Grecian architects and village trades people. Bilingual in English and Greek, Dr. Bea blends global influence with classic sophistication in her work.

Her journey is filled with remarkable milestones. In May 2007, she decorated the stage at the Ohio Theatre with a tranquil, elegant setting fit for a queen, in honor of renowned author and poet Dr. Maya Angelou. In 2023, she was featured on the cover of Fashion Week Columbus Magazine. In 2024, she earned her Ph.D., and in 2025, she was chosen by The Columbus Fashion Council, together with her many followers and friends, as Model of the Year in Columbus, Ohio a recognition that brought tears to her eyes after more than fifty years in the world of fashion, beauty, and design.

Dr. Bea also has a long history of leadership and service. She has served as Commander of the Disabled American Veterans Auxiliary (DAVA) in Columbus, Ohio, is a past board member of the Columbus Historical Society (appointed by then-Mayor Michael Coleman), and is a past Chair of Twig 110, where she helped sponsor the Ebony Fashion Show and raise over \$100,000 for Children's Hospital.

Today, Dr. Bea continues to design, model, speak, and mentor—using her gifts to create beautiful spaces, inspire confidence, and prove that style, grace, and purpose are truly ageless.

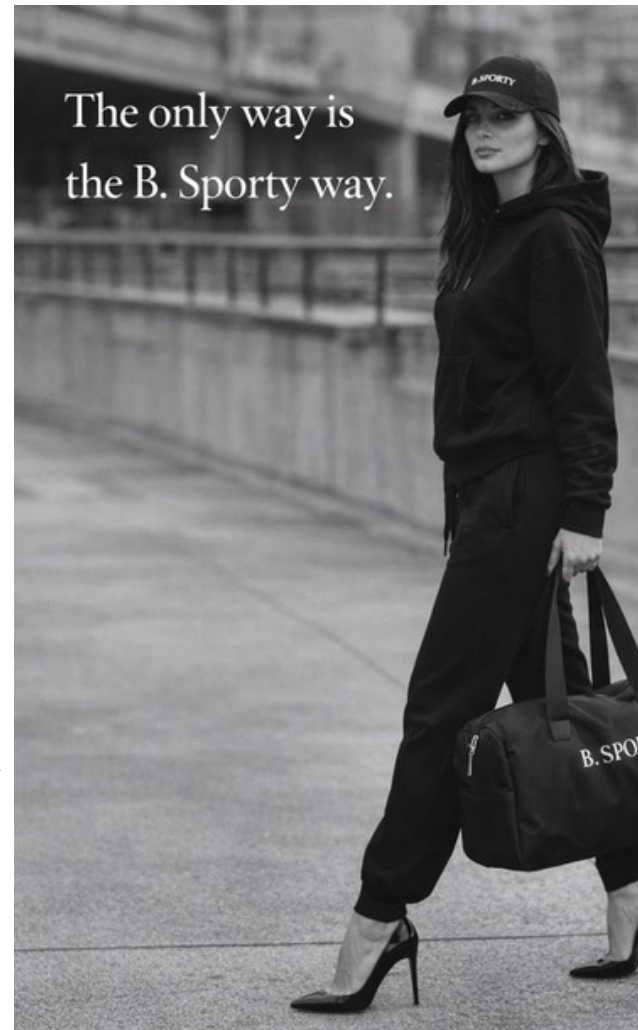

“I came to handle business — and I'll do it with grace and the Dr. Bea. way.”

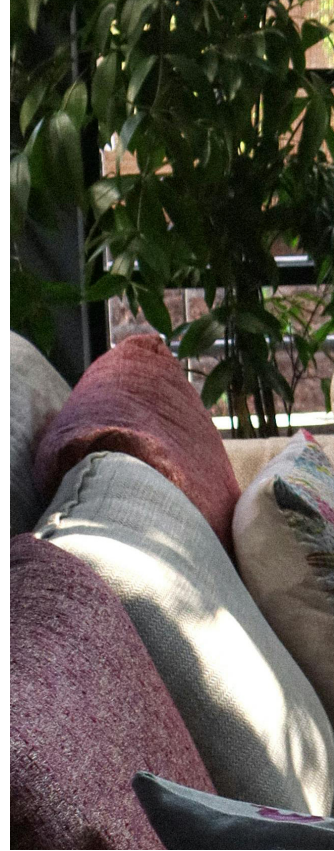
Pair with a silk blouse, a crisp button-down, or even a simple camisole for evening.
